This letter responds to your request for information on behalf of The United States Senate Democratic Policy Committee regarding award fees paid to KBR under the LOGCAP contract.

According to the Army Sustainment Command, no award fees have been approved for payment to KBR for electrical related work performed in Iraq covering the period of performance from January 1, 2008 to the present time. The award fee process is in abeyance until such time as the award fee Determining Official is satisfied that all facts surrounding KBR's performance regarding electrical related work are known to the Government. KBR was paid an award fee of \$34M in April 2008 for work performed and completed in Iraq under LOGCAP III Task Order 139 from September 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007.
