Dear Mr. Chairman:

This letter responds to your request dated April 29, 2009, on behalf of the Democratic Policy Committee (DPC) for information and documents related to the Army Field Support Command's granting of award fees to Kellogg, Brown & Root under LOGCAP III.

Department of Defense policy is to fully cooperate with Congressional Committee requests for documents. Consistent with long-standing practice, requests for documents from the DPC and also from Members of Congress in their individual capacity are treated under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act.

We have initiated a search and collection effort for the documents you have requested. Most of the records you request are maintained by the Army Sustainment Command. The command estimates that there are potentially five hundred thousand pages of responsive documents. Accordingly, they estimate that this effort will take several months to complete.

I trust that this information is helpful. Thank you for your continued support of our Soldiers and Army.
